




A new season in our lives!! Steef fulltime again!!

Invitations to come and teach courses increase. More than time to devote ourselves fulltime to missions again. Our motives? Read on ...



Our vision

Time and again we hear reports that Muslims occupy parts of Africa. Islam influence increases in Kenya. French soldiers fight to stop the islamic march in Mali. We want to strengthen the Christians in those areas! How are we planning to do that?

1. By training Africans from the south to go to the north as missionaries. As long as the possibility exists we want to tell as many people as possible about Jesus, Who wants to set them free from their sin and from the fears that many struggle with.

2. By training children's workers, teaching them how to lead children to Christ, as long as freedom in their countries lasts.

Need

More and more invitations reach us to come and train missionaries. We also notice that the young church has too little passion to work with children. In most indigenous churches there are no children's services. We want to train local leaders and teach them how to present Bible stories and their meaning to the children, so that also this new generation will stand firm in their faith.



A Matter of the Heart

It is the heart of God to save people for eternity and to give them peace and freedom already now, in our era. We share the same passion. At the moment Steef travels alone, most of the time. In faith we set him free to do so. I work almost 5 days a week, but would like to devote my time to training children's workers in Africa. Ideally we would like to go together again, from now on.

Who is going to back us up with prayer and finances, so that we can perform this beautiful task on an ongoing basis?

What has already been done with your help:

- In the first quarter of 2013 more people have been trained by Steef than in the two previous years combined!
- Ps. Michel Ngalula has revised the French course book and 250 copies have been printed.
- The Lord opens many doors in the D.R. Congo; it is a strategic country.
- We see a lot of interest there: over a 100 people come to every course week.
- From December 2012 Steef trained prospective missionaries in Kenya, Congo, South Äfrica and Swaziland. In South Africa he was a guest speaker at the annual WEC Conference 2013.

What is going to happen in the coming months

- In June Steef flies to the DR Congo for 2 weeks. Mission seminars have been organised in different churches in Lubumbashi. He expects to train over 200 people there.
- Then follows a 3-day seminar for pastors in South Africa, which he teaches with 2 colleagues.
- In August we plan to go together for 5 weeks and will then both teach courses in Swaziland and Botswana.
- So, in both countries we will teach mission courses and provide training for children's workers.

Join us? You can do it in two ways:

Firstly, we seek people who are willing to support us every month, so that we can continue to travel together. Our present amount of missionary ministry can no longer be combined with secular jobs, but we still need an income, of course.



Secondly, you can donate to our projects. This time we ask your attention for the training of children's workers.
